CD Cops Arrest 4, Seize Firearms, Ammunition and Narcotics

Central Division police have arrested four persons and seized two firearms, quantities of ammunition, and various amounts of narcotics during several intelligence-led exercises conducted across the division over the past 48 hours.

Between 8 p.m. on Saturday 8th November, 2025, and 1 a.m. this morning, a team of officers of the Central Division Task Force (CDTF), Area North, conducted an intelligence-based exercise. Acting on information, the officers proceeded to Mayers Avenue, Chrissie Trace, Enterprise, where they observed a group of men liming on a bridge along the roadway.

While approaching the group, the officers saw one of the individuals—known to them—throw an object to the ground. The officers stopped, informed the suspect of their observation, and conducted a search. One black .38 Special Revolver loaded with five rounds of .38 ammunition was found. The man, a 30-year-old resident of Enterprise, was arrested and charged with possession of firearm and possession of ammunition.

Earlier that day, between 1:30 p.m. and 7 p.m., another team of CDTF, Area North officers, conducted a search at a Petersfield Main Road, Chaguanas residence, where they found 13.5 grammes of cocaine and 78.3 grammes of cannabis. A 42-year-old man was arrested in connection with the find.

Between 3 p.m. and 10 p.m. the same day, CDTF officers attached to the Area South conducted another intelligence-led exercise. The team proceeded to Fitt Street, Montrose, where they executed a search at the residence of a known offender and of several individuals gathered there. During the search, officers found 123 grammes of cannabis. A 47-year-old man from South Phase Four, Edinburgh 500 was arrested in connection with the find. Also, a

41-year-old man from George Street, Esperanza Village, Couva, was arrested for possession of 1.6 grammes of cocaine.

Additionally, between 7 p.m. and 10:30 p.m. on 7th November, 2025, officers of the Central Division Gang Unit seized another firearm. According to reports, officers executed a search warrant at the home of a 35-year-old man of McCarthy Street, Enterprise. While nothing illegal was found inside the residence, a further search was conducted at the back of the premises in an open area of land, where officers discovered a black plastic bag containing one Smith & Wesson firearm, five rounds of 9mm ammunition, and two rounds of .38 Special ammunition. The items were seized, and investigations are ongoing.
