San Juan Man Granted \$100,000 Bail for Sexual Touching of Girl, 8

A 36-year-old man was granted \$100,000 bail with surety when he appeared before a Port-of-Spain Magistrate yesterday charged with sexual touching of an eight-year-old girl.

TONEY-MARC DAVIS, of Laventille Road, San Juan, will reappear before the court on April 23rd.

DAVIS was arrested on March 24th and charged on March 25th by WPC Pamphile of the Western Division Child Protection Unit (CPU) with one count of sexual touching of a child.

The charge stems from a report made to police in 2019 that a man allegedly sexually touched her while at a location in West Trinidad.

Investigations into the details surrounding the alleged incident, led by W/Supt Claire-Guy Alleyne, ASP Roberts, W/Insp Paul and Cpl (Ag.) Davis-Guerra, ended with the arrest of **DAVIS** who was subsequently charged with the offence.

The arrest was made possible by the support of Senior Superintendent of Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF), Oswain Subero, officers of the North-Eastern Division Task Force (NEDTF) and WPCs Beckles and Samuel of the CPU.
