2 fined a total of \$10,000 for possession of ammunition

Two men and a minor appeared before a Princes Town Magistrate on Thursday 25th March 2021, charged with being in possession of ammunition.

The two men were fined, one for \$7,000 or in default will have to serve nine months hard labour, while the second was fined \$3,000 or in default will have to serve six months hard labour. The minor was remanded to the Youth Training and Rehabilitation Centre. (YTRC).

They appeared virtually before Magistrate Indira Misir-Gosine at the Princes Town Magistrates' Court.

CALVIN JAMES, 28, of O'Meara Road, Emerald Gardens, Arima, and **JOSE METIVIER,** 42, Lachance Road, Arima, were arrested and charged during an anti-crime exercise conducted by officers of the Southern Division Task Force.

On Sunday 21st March, 2021 around 11:15pm, PC Baker was on mobile patrol along Manahambre Road, Princes Town, and based on information received, he stopped a white B15 vehicle, driven by Metivier, and with James and the minor in the vehicle. A search was conducted of the vehicle where seven rounds of .45 ammunition were found on the floor. They were all arrested. Following investigations by officers of Southern Division Task Force, they were charged. The minor will be sentenced today at the Juvenile Court.
