Two Held with Firearms and Ammunition in ND, ED and CD Exercises

Two suspects were held with firearms and quantities of ammunition, during separate anti-crime exercises recently conducted in the Northern, Eastern and Central Divisions.

Reports indicate that officers of the Northern Division conducted an exercise in the Arima district, between 1 pm and 5 pm, on Friday 28th November, 2025, which was spearheaded by ACP Singh, W/Snr. Supt. Maynard-Wilson, Supt. Mc Kenzie, ASP Ablacksingh and Sgt. Haynes, and included officers of the Arima Criminal Investigations Department (CID).

During the exercise, officers were proceeding along Church Street, Arima, when they observed a male suspect walking along the roadway. The man was stopped and searched and found to be in possession of one Ruger pistol loaded with a magazine containing nine rounds of ammunition.

The suspect is a 23-year-old of Arima.

Meanwhile, in the Eastern Division investigations into a report of Shooting with Intent to do Grievous Bodily Harm, led to the arrest of one male suspect, who was found hiding in an abandoned house in the Sangre Grande district, on November 25th, 2025.

The suspect, a 33-year-old of Sangre Grande, was found to be in possession of one firearm loaded with a magazine containing three rounds of ammunition and 29 twelve-gauge cartridges.

He is expected to be charged with the following offences and appear before a Master of the High Court this week:

- Shooting with Intent to do Grievous Bodily Harm
- Possession of Firearm

The investigation was supervised by Insp. Harper and included officers of the Sangre Grande CID.

In the Central Division, Task Force officers conducted an intelligence-led operation in the Cunupia district, early this morning, which led to the discovery of one Glock pistol loaded with a magazine containing ten rounds of ammunition and a quantity of cocaine with an estimated street value of TT\$15,000.

The exercise, conducted between 12 am and 4 am, on Sunday 30th November, 2025, was coordinated by Supt. Glodon, ASP Hernandez, Insp. (Ag.) Joseph, Sgt. Harriot and W/Sgt. (Ag.) King and included officers of the Cunupia CID, Cunupia Police Station and the Canine Unit.

And, several operations were conducted between 7 am on Saturday 29th November, 2025 and 7 am, today, in the Southern, South Western and Northern Divisions by officers of the Emergency Response Patrol Branch.

These exercises were spearheaded by ACP Hazel, Snr. Supt. Sooker, Supt. Robain and ASP Warded and supervised by Insp. (Ag.) Sankar, Insp. (Ag.) Alleyne, Insp. Saunders and various base commanders.

During the exercises, several vehicles were searched resulted in the seizure of one imitation firearm and a quantity of cannabis.

Investigations are ongoing into the above matters.
