Firearm, Ammunition, Drugs Seized in Operation Strike Back 3

Police seized one firearm and a quantity of ammunition and narcotics during an Operation Strike Back 3 exercise in South Trinidad yesterday.

Acting on information, officers attached to the Southern Division Task Force (SDTF) and Canine Branch, executed five search warrants and targeted two priority offenders in the Marabella and Claxton Bay communities in which they discovered one Tarus Titanium P24/7 nine millimetre Pistol with three rounds of ammunition and found a clear plastic bag which contained 500 grams of cannabis along Soledad Road, Claxton Bay.

The SDTF and Canine officers also found 550 grams of cannabis in the vicinity of the fishing depot along Southern Main Road, Claxton Bay.

Investigations into the discoveries are ongoing.
