Labourer Granted \$65000 Bail for Threats to Kill and Breach of Protection Order

A 39-year-old Skilled Labourer from Point Fortin, was granted bail in the sum of \$65,000.00, when he appeared before a South Master's Court on Tuesday 22nd October, 2024, to answer to charges; 2 counts of Threats to Kill, 2 counts of Breach of Protection Order, 1 count of Actual Bodily Harm, 1 count of Larceny from the person.

The suspect is expected to reappear before the court on November 25th, 2024. He was also ordered to leave his current residence and reside at another and to stay 100 feet away from the victim. He is also to report to the Point Fortin Police Station twice per week.

It was reported that on Friday 18th October, 2024, the victim came home from work and met the alleged offender who accused her of being unfaithful. The offender then used obscene language towards the victim. He also took her mobile phone after having an altercation with her and dealt her several blows to her back.

A report was made on the same day and he was subsequently arrested.

The defendant was charged on Tuesday 22nd, October, 2024
