## Scaffolder Charged with Burglary, Malicious Damage

**MARVIN GABRIEL** will appear before a Siparia Magistrate today to answer to the charge of burglary and two counts of malicious damage.

The charges stem from an incident which occurred on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> November, 2020 at 1 pm where a couple of Gamble Street, Siparia, were awoken by the sound of the suspect attempting to enter their home through a window.

The couple raised an alarm and the man retreated from entering the house and instead turned his attention to a Nissan B-13 vehicle parked at the front of the house.

The victims told police that a man began smashing the vehicle with a wheel spanner and hammer, damaging both the front and rear windshields, both front head lights, rear left side tail light and right side indicator light.

The suspect then approached their home and began smashing louvre panes. He then left and began running along Gamble Street, Siparia.

Officers of the Siparia Police Station were called in and checks were made for the suspect who was later arrested along Grell Street, Siparia.

WPC Vincent subsequently charged **MARVIN GABRIEL**, 32, a scaffolder of Quarry Road, Morne Diablo, for the offences of burglary and two counts of malicious damage.
