Man, 42, Charged following Violent Episode to 3 Women

A 42-year-old La Brea man was remanded into custody after appearing before a Point Fortin Magistrate on Tuesday charged with assaulting two women during a domestic incident.

The man also destroyed the property of a third woman during the ordeal.

The accused, who pleaded not guilty to two counts of malicious damage and one count of assault by beating and assault occasioning actual bodily harm, respectively, was granted \$100,000 bail with a surety by Magistrate Alicia Chankar.

He was ordered to keep 100 metres away from all three women as part of his bail conditions.

The man is expected to reappear before the court on June 14th, 2022.

He was arrested on May 14th and later charged on May 16th by PC Williams of the South-Western Division Gender-Based Violence Unit (GBVU).

According to police reports, at 4 pm on May 14th, a woman was at home when her boyfriend allegedly arrived at the house intoxicated.

The woman, a nail technician, told GBVU detectives that she and the man had a disagreement concerning a request that he made as she was dealing with a customer at the time.

After the customer left, an argument ensued and the man allegedly dealt her several cuffs about the face and head. The woman also lost three plaits during the melee.

The man also allegedly continued the attack destroying several household appliances and allegedly assaulting another woman at the location at the time.

Investigations, supervised by Cpl Singh, resulted in the arrest and charges being laid to the suspect.
