Firearms, Narcotics Seized in Multiple Operations Across Divisions

The Trinidad and Tobago Police Service (TTPS) continues to execute targeted, intelligence-led operations under the State of Emergency to disrupt criminal activity and enhance public safety. A series of exercises conducted on Friday 19th September, 2025, across multiple divisions resulted in significant seizures and arrests.

North Central Division

During a roving road check operation between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. in the Valsayn district, officers received information of men seen disposing cannabis into dustbins along Bassie Street, Real Spring, Valsayn. Officers made checks in the area and found in a blue dustbin along the said roadway, a garbage bag containing several black packets wrapped in plastic wrapping, which contained 3 kilograms of cannabis and 125 grams of cocaine.

Western Division

Between 5:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m., officers conducted a crime eradication exercise in the St. James Police District. A search at Waterhole Road, Cocorite, led to the discovery of a Glock pistol loaded with 15 rounds of 9mm ammunition hidden at the back of a mosque in the vicinity of the wash area.

Port of Spain Division

As part of 'Operation Safer City', officers conducted searches in the Belmont Police District which resulted in the recovery of one pistol with seven rounds of .45 calibre ammunition and the arrest of two suspects.

Eastern Division

Between 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., an intelligence-led SOE raid and drug block search was conducted in the Sangre Grande district. While conducting surveillance at the residence of an 18-year-old on Pine Avenue, Ojoe Road, officers observed another man removing items from a washing machine located at the rear of the premises. Officers searched the area in the presence of the two individuals which resulted in the discovery of four packets of cannabis. The narcotics, weighing 2.11 kilograms and valued at approximately \$63,300, were seized. Both men were detained as investigations continue.

Investigations are continuing.
