Arima Man Fined \$16,150 for Malicious Damage to Marked Police Vehicle

A 26-year-old man appeared before Magistrate, Her Worship Cheron Raphael in the Arima Magistrate's Court on Wednesday 8th April, 2020, charged with malicious damage to a marked police vehicle, obscene language, resisting arrest and throwing missiles.

BRANDON ATKINS, of Printeryville Omera Road, Arima, was arrested by PC Brewster of the Arima Police Station on Wednesday 8th April, 2020.

Brandon Atkins pleaded guilty and was fined TT\$11,650 and TT\$4500 for malicious damage to a TTPS vehicle, or in default five months hard labour.
