Six Held in Eastern and Tobago Divisions For Firearm, Narcotics and Robbery Offences

Six suspects were arrested for various offences by officers of the Eastern and Tobago Divisions, during anti-crime exercises yesterday.

In the first exercise, officers of the Rio Claro police station were conducting road check duties between 2:20 am and 6:50 pm, on Monday 9th June, 2025, when they stopped a black Hyundai Elantra motor vehicle, with two occupants.

A search of the vehicle resulted in the discovery of one pistol, two magazines and a total of 32 rounds of ammunition.

The two occupants of the vehicle, a 40-year-old man of Tacarigua and a 21-year-old woman of Port of Spain, were arrested in connection with the finds.

Meanwhile, in the Valencia district, Criminal Investigations Department officers conducted an exercise between 4:30 pm and 7 pm, yesterday, during which they intercepted a white Kia K2700 pickup truck with three occupants, including a 17-year-old male.

A search of the vehicle resulted in officers finding one pistol loaded with a magazine containing 15 rounds of ammunition.

The minor and the other two suspects, a 46-year-old and a 22-year-old, both of Valencia, were arrested.

The teenager is said to be wanted by detectives of the Homicide Bureau of Investigations, Region Two, in relation to a March 2025 murder in the Sangre Grande district.

And, in the Tobago district, officers of the Inter-Agency Task Force conducted an exercise around 10:15 pm, yesterday, during which they proceeded to the Riseland district, where they observed a white Tiida motor vehicle which was involved in a recent robbery incident.

Checks of a nearby apartment building resulted in the discovery of 2.6 kilogrammes of cannabis and a quantity of cocaine.

One man was subsequently arrested in connection with the report of Robbery.

Investigations are ongoing into all of the above incidents.
