Seven Held, Three Firearms, Ammunition and Cannabis Seized in Weekend Operations

Seven persons were arrested and three firearms and quantities of ammunition and cannabis seized during anti-crime operations conducted in the Southern, South Western and Port of Spain Divisions this weekend.

In the Southern Division, officers proceeded to the South Park district, around 7 pm, on Friday 12th September, 2025, where they arrested two male suspects and seized on pistol and three rounds of ammunition from a white Nissan Tiida motor vehicle.

The suspects, ages 33 and 32, are both from Princes Town.

Meanwhile, an intelligence-based exercise conducted between 11 am and 12 noon, yesterday in the Southern Division, resulted in the arrest of two male suspects, ages 30 and 33, of New Grant and Princes Town respectively, for Trafficking of Cannabis.

And, Southern Division Task Force officers conducted an exercise between 2 pm and 7 pm, yesterday, during which two male suspects, were arrested for the offences of Possession of Cannabis and Possession of Cocaine for Trafficking.

These exercises were coordinated by Snr. Supt. Simon, Supt. Jaikaran, Supt. Sooker and ASP Ramsaran.

In the South Western Division, Task Force officers, assisted by the Point Fortin Criminal Investigations Department and Canine Unit, conducted a State of Emergency Operation around 6:13 am on Saturday 13th September, 2025 in the Point Fortin district.

During the exercise, the home of a male suspect was searched and a revolver loaded with five rounds of ammunition and a quantity of cannabis seized.

The man was arrested in connection with the finds.

And, officers of the Port of Spain Division, conducted an exercise yesterday between 2 pm and 5 pm in the Belmont and Besson Street districts, during which they seized a quantity of cannabis.

Investigations are ongoing into all of the above matters.
