## 2 Arrested, Stolen Vehicles Recovered in Northern and North Central Divisions

Officers of the Stolen Vehicles Squad have arrested a man and recovered a stolen vehicle yesterday, Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> October, 2024.

During an intelligence led operation, officers proceeded to a home, off Short Street Train Line Road, Pinto Road, Arima and executed a search warrant relative to an investigation involving the larceny of a Silver Nissan Sentra which was reported stolen between the period February 28, 2023 to March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023, in the La Horquetta Police District, nothing pertaining to the warrant was found. However, a silver coloured Toyota Corolla Hybrid Fielder Wagon motor vehicle bearing no registration plates was observed parked on the northern side of the premises.

Further checks of the vehicle revealed that it was stolen, the 45year-old man was arrested and is assisting officers with further investigations. The suspect was taken to Central Police Station along with the stolen vehicles.

In another intelligence lead operation conducted by members of North Central Division Task Force in the Arouca district officers proceeded to the Trincity Mall car park and apprehended a suspect and seized the stolen silver Nissan Tiida he was driving. The suspect also failed to produce a valid Drivers Permit and Certificate of Insurance. The driver was arrested and conveyed along with the vehicle to Arouca Police Station.
