'Operation Strike Back'

48-hour operation conducted nationwide from January 11th to 13th. 138 persons arrested, 8 firearms and a quantity ammunition seized, 22 drug blocks searched and 2 stolen vehicles recovered.

To date there have been 19 Operation Strike Back exercises.

TTPS Distributes Cheques to Officers Affected by Flooding

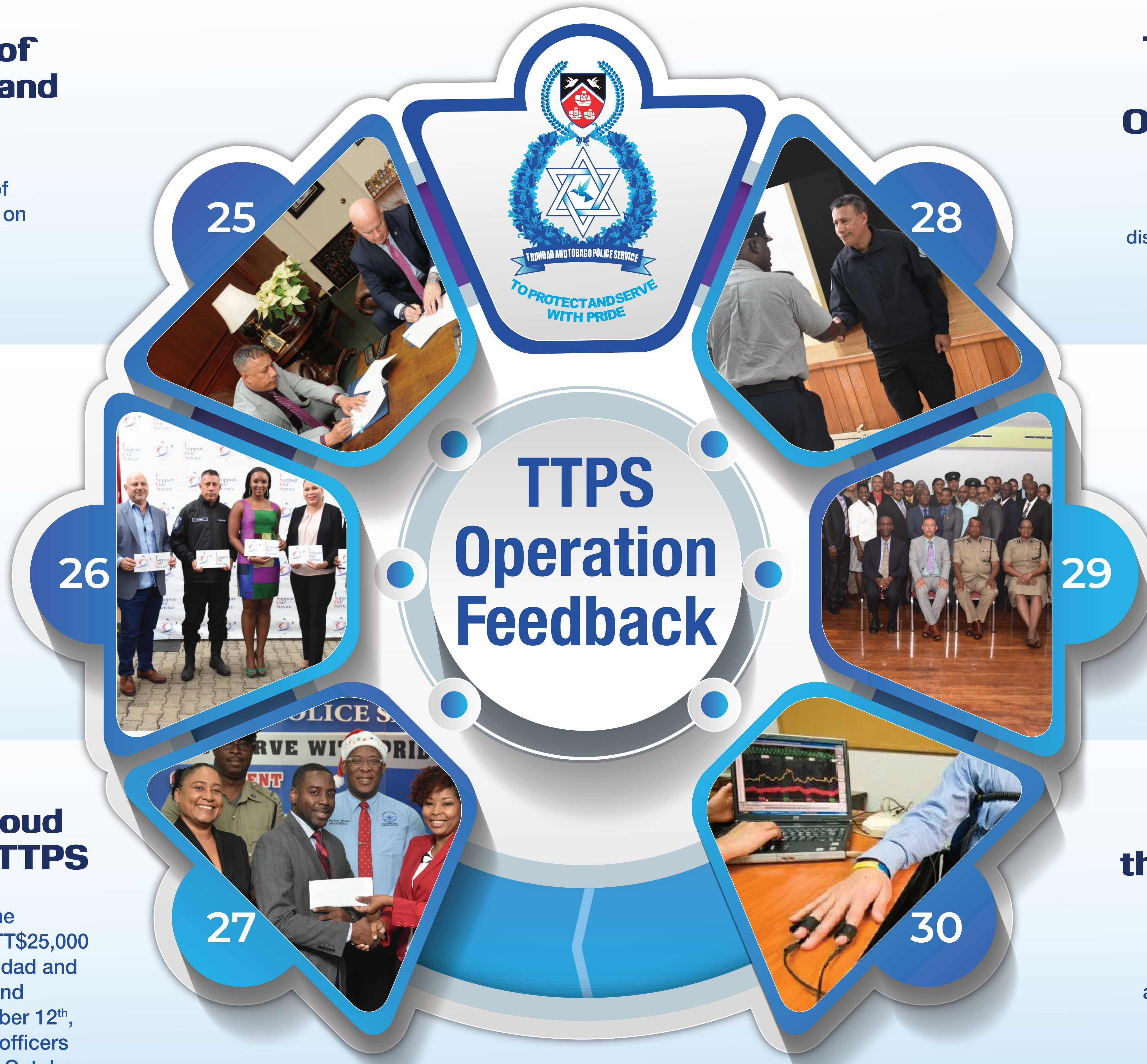
Members of the TTPS executive distribute 232 cheques and vouchers to officers affected by flooding on Thursday 13th December, 2018.
