Seven Held, Firearm, Ammunition and Cannabis Seized

Seven persons were arrested for various offences, while a firearm and quantities of ammunition and cannabis were seized during anti-crime exercises conducted in three Divisions yesterday.

In the Western Division, Task Force officers conducted a State of Emergency exercise between 7 pm and 11 pm, on Sunday 16th March, 2025, during which they proceeded to the Cameron Road district, where they conducted a search.

Officers found one rifle loaded with a magazine containing six rounds of 5.56 ammunition during the search.

The operation was sanctioned by Snr. Supt. Williams and ASP Lynch, coordinated by Insp. Grant, and spearheaded by Sgt. Hunte.

In the North Eastern Division, officers of the Morvant Police Station, Morvant Criminal Investigations Department and personnel of the Trinidad and Tobago Defence Force, conducted an anti-crime exercise between 12 noon and 4 pm, yesterday, during which they proceeded to Cipriani Avenue, Second Caledonia.

There, they carried out a search under a derelict vehicle, which resulted in the discovery of a quantity of cannabis.

Meanwhile, in the Southern Division, Task Force officers, assisted by officers of the Princes Town Police Station and Court and Process Branch, conducted an anti-crime operation in the district, which resulted in the arrest of seven persons for various offences.

The suspects, ages 18 to 55, all of the Southern Division, were held for offences such as Breach of Protection Order, Assault by Threats, Possession of Narcotics, House Breaking and Larceny and Outstanding Warrants.
