### **MEDIA RELEASE**

#### **Suspect Detained, Stolen Items Recovered Following Housebreaking and Larceny in Mayaro**

---

A suspect is currently detained, and a quantity of stolen items has been recovered following a report of housebreaking and larceny in Mayaro earlier today.

At approximately 5:00 a.m. on Tuesday, 12th August 2025, the victim, a 33-year-old woman of Newlands Village, Guayaguayare, secured her home and left for work. Around 12:30 p.m., she was alerted that a man had been seen fleeing from the rear of her residence with an item in hand.

Upon returning home, the victim discovered that a window on the southern side of the house had been broken. A search of the premises revealed that approximately \$36,600 in gold jewellery and \$1,000 in Trinidad and Tobago currency were missing.

A report was made to the Mayaro Criminal Investigations Department (CID), and an investigation was immediately launched, including interviews, a review of surveillance footage, and evidence gathering.

Based on information received, officers proceeded to the home of the suspect—a 21-year-old man of Newlands Village, Guayaguayare—where he was detained pending further enquiries.

Following a comprehensive investigation, the suspect led officers to a forested area in La Savanne Circular, where all of the stolen jewellery and \$300 in cash were recovered.

The victim positively identified the recovered items as her property. The suspect remains in custody as investigations continue.
