Four Arrested, Fifteen Penalty Issued in DUI Enforcement Operation in POS

A DUI Enforcement Operation conducted yesterday resulted in the arrest of four men and the issuance of fifteen Fixed Penalty Notices.

The operation was carried out between the hours of 10:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 17, 2025, and 2:00 a.m. on Friday, April 18, 2025, along the Churchill Roosevelt Highway (C.R.H), Beetham Highway, and Wrightson Road, Port of Spain.

Four individuals were arrested and charged for driving with breath alcohol levels above the legal limit: a 69-year-old man from Jaffar Street, Bamboo Settlement, Valsayn – 78 μ g/100 ml, a 42-year-old man from St. Francois Valley Road, Belmont – 50 μ g/100 ml, a 50-year-old man from El Socorro Road, San Juan – 72 μ g/100 ml and a 42-year-old man from Benny Street, Dinsley Village, Tacarigua – 45 μ g/100 ml.

Additional Enforcement Actions:

A total of fifteen (15) Fixed Penalty Notices (FPNs) were issued for the following offenses:

- 6 No Insurance
- 3 No Head Lamps
- 2 No ID Lights
- 2 Defaced ID Plate
- 1 No Inspection
