Shotgun, Cannabis, Ammo Seized

A series of intelligence-led anti-crime operations on Friday 1st November 2024, resulted in the seizure of two illegal firearms, ammunition and a quantity of cannabis.

In the Western Division, around 8:45 pm yesterday, a party of officers proceeded to the western car park of the Movie Towne Complex, where they searched a white Nissan B15 vehicle. A shotgun loaded with one round of 12-gauge ammunition was found. A man from Chaguanas was taken into custody and faces charges related to firearm possession.

Meanwhile, in Tobago, during a drug block exercise officers searched a bushy area along Pirates Bay Road, Charlotteville, where they found and took possession of a Glock 19 firearm and ammunition.

In the Central Division, based on intelligence gathered, officers proceeded to Cito Lane, Tabaquite where they searched an abandoned wooden structure. There, they found one crocus bag containing dried cannabis, which weighed 1.586kg with an estimated street value of \$10,000.

Also acting on intelligence, around 1:45 am today, officers of the Southern Division found an extended Glock magazine and eight rounds of ammunition under rubble on an abandoned parcel of land in Springvale Village, San Fernando.

Investigations are ongoing.
