One Held, Two Firearms, Ammunition and Cannabis Seized

One man was arrested and two firearms and quantities of ammunition and cannabis seized, during anti-crime exercises conducted in the Southern and North Eastern Divisions yesterday into this morning.

In the latest incident, Task Force officers in the Southern Division, conducted an exercise around 12:30 am on Friday 20th June, 2025, during which they attempted to intercept a vehicle in the Claxton Bay district.

The driver allegedly refused to stop and a chase ensued ending along the Caroni Savannah Road.

A search of the vehicle resulted in officers finding 1.2 kilogrammes of cannabis hidden in the trunk.

The suspect, a 43-year-old Morvant man was arrested in connection with the find.

Meanwhile, an anti-crime operation was conducted in the Santa Cruz and San Juan districts between 5 am and 9 am, on Thursday 19th June, 2025.

The operation was spearheaded by Snr. Supt. (Ag.) Carty, Supt. Birch and ASP Callendar and included officers of the Santa Cruz

Criminal Investigations Department (CID), the San Juan CID, North Eastern Division Task Force and the Canine Branch.

During the exercise, officers found one Beretta pistol loaded with a magazine containing 15 rounds of ammunition in a bushy area at El Carmen Road.

One pellet gun was also found in the Upper Santa Cruz district and a quantity of cannabis discovered along Saddle Road, San Juan.

Investigations are ongoing into the above matters.
