## Mason Hall Fisherman to be Sentenced for Revolver, Ammo Possession

A Mason Hall Man who pleaded guilty yesterday before a Master of the High Court in Scarborough to possession of a revolver and four rounds of ammunition was remanded into custody pending sentencing.

**BRUCE MC CLEAN, 35, a fisherman, of Main Road, Mason Hall,** will be given his sentence on April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024, after his matter was heard virtually on March 18<sup>th</sup> before Master Sarah De Silva.

**MC CLEAN** was arrested on March 14<sup>th</sup> and later charged on March 15<sup>th</sup> with the offences by Sgt Jonas of the Scarborough Criminal Investigations Department (CID).

According to police reports, at 10.30 pm on March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2024, police officers attached to the Scarborough CID were on an exercise along Main Road, Mt. Grace, in the vicinity of Harmony Hall Junction, Scarborough, when they observed a male suspect walking suspiciously in an easterly direction along the said road.

The CID detectives also observed the man sporting a black strap bag slung across his chest.

Police approached the man and upon questioning him, he allegedly began running away.

He was chased and quickly apprehended by police who carried out a search of the man and the bag.

During the search, CID detectives allegedly discovered a wooden handle .38 revolver with four rounds of .38 ammunition.

The suspect was immediately taken into police custody.
