Police Arrests Two, Seize Firearm and Recover Vehicle after Trincity Robbery

Quick response by officers of the Emergency Response Patrol (ERP) of the North Central Division, led to the arrest of two suspects and the seizure of a Pistol along with a magazine and ten rounds of ammunition along Dinsley Avenue, Trincity on Sunday 27th October, 2024.

At around 2:30pm yesterday the victim was parked along Casselton Avenue Trincity in his red Honda CRV attempting to purchase a snow cone when he was approached by two men, one of whom was armed with a firearm and announced a robbery causing the victim to become fearful. Both men then relieved the victim of his motor vehicle and drove away in a westerly direction then north along Dinsley Avenue making good their escape.

The victim contacted the Police and made a report and as a result a broadcast was sent by the Command Center and around 3:50pm the vehicle was spotted proceeding west along the Churchill Roosevelt Highway (CRH) in the vicinity of Valpark. A chase ensued and the vehicle turned off the CRH unto El Socorro Extension where it collided with a gate along Chanka Trace and the both suspects alighted. With the assistance of units in the North Eastern Division which included Inter Agency Task Force, Guard and Emergency Branch and Highway Patrol the suspects were apprehended and 1 9mm Luger Pistol along with 1 magazine and 10 rounds 9mm ammunition were recovered. Both suspects along with the firearm was conveyed to the Arouca Police Station. The vehicle was also wrecked and taken to the Arouca Police Station.

Investigations are ongoing.
