### MEDIA RELEASE

#### **Stolen Vehicle Recovered, Teen Arrested and Charged in Robbery with Violence Case**

An intelligence-led operation conducted by officers of the Stolen Vehicles Squad, North-Central Division, resulted in the recovery of a stolen vehicle and the arrest of a teenage suspect in connection with a Robbery with Violence that occurred in July 2025.

#### **Incident Summary:**

At approximately 12:30 a.m. on Sunday 20th July, 2025, the victim was driving his grey Nissan Note, valued at \$130,000 TT, when he was flagged down by two men requesting a drop. Suspect 1: African descent, slim build, dark brown complexion, approx. 5'9", small afro hairstyle. Suspect 2: African descent, medium build, dark brown complexion, approx. 5'11", afro hairstyle.

Shortly after entering the vehicle, Suspect 2 announced a robbery, brandishing what appeared to be a piece of iron. In fear for his life, the victim attempted to flee on foot with the vehicle key. However, both suspects pursued and physically assaulted him, relieving him of: the vehicle key, his wallet containing \$400 TTD, a black iPhone 12 Pro Max, valued at \$3,500 TTD. The suspects then escaped with the victim's vehicle.

#### **Breakthrough in Investigation:**

On Friday 3rd October 2025, between 6:15 p.m. and 10:35 p.m., based on surveillance and intelligence gathered over two weeks, officers proceeded to Palm Avenue, Casselton Avenue, Cane Farm, Trincity.

There, they observed a grey Nissan Note parked along the roadside. A database check confirmed it was the same vehicle stolen during the robbery.

A male individual, matching the suspect description from the original report, was seen standing beside the vehicle. The officers approached and interviewed the suspect, who later handed over the key for the vehicle. He was identified as a 17- years old male, of Poinsettia Extension, Coconut Drive, Morvant.

He was arrested and cautioned in relation to the Robbery with Violence report. The stolen vehicle was photographed and towed to the Arouca Police Station for further processing. The suspect was subsequently taken to the Juvenile Detention Center at Maracas St. Joseph Police Station.

**Charge and Court Appearance:**

On Thursday 9th October 2025, an interview was conducted and the suspect was later positively identified by the victim.

As a result, the teen was formally charged on Friday 10th October 2025 with Robbery with Violence. He was granted bail in the sum of \$100,000 TT with surety when he appeared before Justice Rodriguez.

The matter was adjourned to November 21st, 2025.
