Wallerfield Man Granted \$400,000 Bail on Robbery with Violence Charges

A 30-year-old man from Wallerfield has been granted bail in the sum of \$400,000 after being charged with two counts of **Robbery with Violence**. The accused, appeared virtually before Master Rehanna Hosein today at the Port of Spain Court.

He is expected to reappear in court on Thursday 29th May, 2025.

The charges relate to a violent home invasion which occurred at approximately 7:30 p.m. on Saturday, March 16, 2025. During the incident, five masked men dressed in dark clothing, one armed with a firearm, entered the home of the victim. The assailants ordered the victim and a caretaker to lie on the ground, beat them, and tied their hands and feet.

The suspects reportedly stole the following items:

- Three vehicles:
 - Black Mercedes Benz is valued at \$200,000.00
 - White Toyota Land Cruiser \$300,000.00
 - Bronze Porsche SUV \$150,000.00
- \$21,000 TTD in cash
- Wallet containing:
 - Republic Bank credit card
 - Driver's permit
 - Personal items and documents
- Jewellery and alcohol (value pending)
- A Smith & Wesson .38 revolver and ammunition
- One Trinidad and Tobago passport
- Foreign currency: US\$1,500 and £100
- Two mobile phones
- Firearm User's License booklet

The suspects escaped in the stolen vehicles, which were later recovered intact.

A joint intelligence-led investigation was launched by the Port of Spain Criminal Investigations Department, Criminal Investigations Department/ Criminal Records Office, Special Branch, National Special Operations Unit,

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headed by ACP Richard Smith and the Cyber Crime Unit. This led to the arrest of a 30year old mechanic of Demerara Heights, Wallerfield. He was subsequently charged by Sgt Brebnor.

The investigation was supervised by Snr. Supt. Raymond Thom, Superintendents. Nichols and Jankie, ASP Soodeen, and Insp. Mohammed.
