TT\$1.8M in Cash Seized from Maraval House

One woman was arrested by officers of the Western Division after over TT\$1.8 million in cash was found at her Maraval home yesterday morning.

An exercise was conducted between 4 am and 8 am, on Wednesday 15th October, 2025, in the Maraval district, by officers of the West End/Maraval Criminal Investigations Department (CID), with the assistance of the West End Police Station, the Western Division Task Force, the WD Gang and Intelligence Unit, the Inter-Agency Task Force, and the Canine Unit.

During the exercise, the officers proceeded to the home of a male suspect, where they conducted a search.

The search resulted in the discovery of a safe, within which TT\$1,853,600 and \$837 Barbadian Currency, were found. Four police patches and a pair of black tactical pants were also seized.

The suspect's mother, who was in the house at the time of the exercise, was taken into custody.

Personnel of the Financial Investigations Bureau were contacted and the cash seized in accordance with the Proceeds of Crime Act.

Meanwhile, one firearm was found following a report of Robbery with Aggravation in the Barataria district, yesterday.

Reports say a female victim was at her Barataria business place around 7:20 am, in the company of another woman, when they were approached by two men, one armed with a gun.

The victim, who became fearful for her life, ran out of the building and onto the street, while the two suspects ran off with two cellular phones in their possession.

The police were contacted and North Eastern Division Task Force officers visited the scene and recovered the two cellular phones and a firearm loaded with a magazine containing two rounds of ammunition a short distance away.

Investigations are ongoing into the two above matters.
