## MEDIA RELEASE

### **Two Arrested, Narcotics, Firearm and Ammo Seized**

Two individuals have been arrested, and a firearm, ammunition, and several cannabis plants seized in operations conducted in the Port of Spain and Southern Divisions within the past 24 hours.

At approximately 6:00 am in the Port of Spain Division, a party of officers was proceeding west along Picton Road in an unmarked police vehicle, in the vicinity of the John John basketball court, when they observed a man holding what appeared to be a firearm in his right hand. Upon looking in the direction of the vehicle, the suspect reportedly threw the firearm a few metres away from where he was standing. The officers immediately alighted from the vehicle and retrieved the firearm, which was fitted with an extended magazine containing 19 rounds of 9mm ammunition. The suspect, a 24-year-old man from Wharf Trace, Maracas, St. Joseph, was arrested.

In another incident, officers of the Southern Division Task Force and the K9 Unit conducted an anti-crime exercise in Area West of the Southern Division between 7:00 pm on July 5th and 12:00 am on July 6th. During the operation, officers focused on several known drug blocks and executed search warrants. A 28-year-old woman from Bougainville Boulevard, Tarodale, was arrested for possession of cannabis plants in excess of the legal limit.

Also in the Southern Division, acting on information received, officers proceeded to a savannah along Croquette Street, Ste. Madeline, where they conducted a search of the area. There, they found 11 rounds of 9mm ammunition in a black plastic bag located a few metres off the roadway. The ammunition was seized for further processing.

Investigations are ongoing.
