Two Held with Firearm, Ammunition and Narcotics

Two persons were arrested and a firearm and quantities of ammunition and narcotics seized by officers of the South Western Division Task Force and Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) this week.

In the first incident, Task Force officers conducted an exercise around 6:05 pm, on Wednesday 8th May, 2024, during which they proceeded to Fanny Village, Point Fortin, where they executed a search warrant at the home of a female suspect.

The search resulted in officers finding a pistol loaded with a magazine containing 17 rounds of ammunition hidden in a bedroom.

The 42-year-old woman who was in the house at the time of the search was arrested in connection with the find.

And, in the Southern Division, IATF officers intercepted a green Honda Vezel motor vehicle around 11:45 pm, on Thursday 9th May, 2024, proceeding along the Uriah Butler Highway in the vicinity of the Gasparillo over pass.

A search of the vehicle resulted in officers finding approximately two kilogrammes of cocaine.

The driver, a 39-year-old of Arima was arrested in connection with the find.

Investigations are ongoing into the two above matters.
