One Arrested, 3 Stolen Vehicles Recovered

One man was arrested and three stolen vehicles were recovered during exercises conducted in various policing divisions, over the past 72 hours.

On Wednesday 29th August, a San Juan man was arrested and charged by officers of the Stolen Vehicles Squad, in connection with a report of a stolen silver-coloured Toyota Aqua from the Central Division. The 35-year old man, an employee of the Public Transportation Service Corporation, is scheduled to appear before the Chaguanas Magistrates' Court on 21st September, 2023, to answer to the charge.

In another incident, on 31st August, 2023, officers of Arouca Criminal Investigations Department (CID) responded to a report of a stolen Nissan Wingroad. During the search for the stolen vehicle, the officers proceeded to NUGFW Housing Development.
