One Man Arrested, 1080 Grams of Cannabis Seized in Tobago

One man arrested, 1080 Grams of Cannabis Seized in Tobago Division.

The Tobago Divisional Task Force – Area North, in collaboration with several specialized units of the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service, continues to intensify its anti-crime efforts under the 2025 State of Emergency.

On Monday 1st December, 2025, between the hours of 11:45 a.m. and 12:50 p.m., officers conducted a targeted Raid and Search Operation within the Shirvan Road Police Station District.

The exercise was strategically led by W/A.S.P. Area East/West/Operations Bacchus, coordinated by Ag. Sgt. Thomas of the Gang Unit and W/Ag. Sgt. Gordon-Harris, and supervised by W/Cpl. Alfred. The operation included officers of the Tobago Divisional Task Force – Area North, TTPS Gang Unit, Guard and Emergency Branch, Inter-Agency Task Force, the Trinidad and Tobago Regiment, and the TTPS Canine Unit.

Acting on intelligence information, a team led by PC Antoine proceeded to the residence of a 35-year-old labourer of Plymouth and conducted a search of the premises for illegal firearms and ammunition pursuant to the Emergency Powers Regulations.

During the search, officers discovered one rectangular plastic parcel, brown and blue in colour, hidden inside a wardrobe in a room occupied by the suspect. On examination, the parcel was found to contain cannabis, with a total weight of 1080 grams.

The suspect was arrested and conveyed to the Shirvan Road Police Station along with the seized parcel. PC Antoine is continuing investigations.
