Firearm, Ammunition, Cannabis, and Cocaine Seized-CD

A targeted anti-crime operation conducted by the Central Division Task Force (CDTF) – Area South resulted in multiple seizures of illegal firearms,

ammunition, and narcotics within the Couva and Penal Police Districts.

On Thursday, April 17, 2025, between 4:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m., officers

conducted an exercise at Ramlal Trace, Penal, where a suspect discarded

an object into a wooded area and fled the scene. A search of the area led

to the recovery of a pistol. The man, who is known to the officers, is

currently being sought.

During another search in Gran Couva, a male Venezuelan national was

stopped and searched along the roadway. Officers discovered 50 rounds of

9mm ammunition in a backpack in his possession. He was arrested and

is currently assisting police with investigations.

In a separate incident in Mc Bean, Couva, while searching a known drug

block along the Southern Main Road, officers found and seized 940 grams

of cannabis and 48 grams of cocaine.

These seizures underscore the continued efforts of the Central Division to

suppress firearm-related violence and illegal drug activity through

intelligence-led policing and proactive enforcement.

Investigations are ongoing.
