Seven Held, Three Firearms, Ammunition and Narcotics Seized in Weekend Exercises

Seven persons were arrested and three firearms and quantities of ammunition and narcotics seized, during anti-crime exercises conducted across several Divisions yesterday.

In the Eastern Division, officers of the Sangre Grande Police Station, conducted a State of Emergency exercise between 3 pm and 6 pm, on Sunday 23rd, March, 2025.

During the exercise, officers arrested a 40-year-old man for Possession of Firearm and Possession of Ammunition, after finding a homemade shot gun and two 12 gauge cartridges in his vehicle.

Meanwhile, in the Southern Division, Task Force officers assisted by officers of the Canine Branch, conducted an exercise between 11 am and 5 pm, yesterday, in the La Romaine district.

During the exercise, the officers arrested five suspects for varying offences, including Possession of Cannabis and Possession of Cocaine.

Based on information received, the same party of officers then proceeded to the Vistabella district, where they conducted a search of a bushy area along Manjack Street. There, they found one revolver wrapped in a grey plastic bag.

In the Port of Spain Division, officers of the Port of Spain City Police Strike Team conducted an exercise this weekend in the Sea Lots district.

The exercise resulted in the discovery of one firearm and 20 rounds of ammunition, hidden in a wooden structure off Production Avenue.

Meanwhile, officers of the Port of Spain Division conducted an exercise between 8 pm yesterday and 2 am today, focusing on Duncan Street, St. Paul Street, George Street and Beetham Gardens.

One 44-year-old woman was arrested for possession of a quantity of cocaine, a quantity of TT currency and a scale.

Investigations are ongoing into the all of the above matters.
