### **MEDIA RELEASE**

#### **Three Arrested, Cannabis, Firearm and Ammunition Seized**

An intelligence-led anti-crime exercise was conducted across the Southern Division between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. on Friday, October 10<sup>th</sup>, 2025, as part of Operation Steadfast. This targeted initiative aimed at addressing the rise in firearm-related offences, robberies, shootings, and gang activity, with special emphasis on known offenders in the division.

The exercise involved surveillance, searches, and operational tactics executed under Section 12 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, based on intelligence surrounding active gang networks in the area.

During the exercise, officers recovered and seized 62 grams of marijuana and arrested a 27-year-old man of Block J, Embacadere, San Fernando, a 29-year-old man of Block P, Embacadere, San Fernando and a 31-year-old man of Block G, Embacadere, San Fernando.

Additionally, acting on intelligence received, PC Baisden conducted a search at Lady Hailes Avenue, San Fernando, where a firearm was discovered in the vicinity of a building. The object contained two rounds of 9mm ammunition and was seized for further investigation.

The operation was coordinated by Senior Superintendent Simon, Superintendent Jaikaran, W/Superintendent Bridgelal, ASP Santana, and Inspector Wilkinson, and was directly supervised by Ag. Sgt. Charles. Supporting units included officers from the Southern Division Gang Unit, Task Force, Operations Unit, Guard and Emergency Branch (GEB), National Operations Task Force (NOTF), Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF), and the K9 Unit.
