Four Held, Firearm and Dangerous Drugs Seized

Four persons were arrested and a firearm and quantities of narcotics seized during anti-crime exercises, conducted in the North Central and Southern Divisions this week.

In the first exercise, officers of the Major Crimes Unit executed a search warrant for dangerous drugs at the Trincity home of a 30-year-old woman and her 39-year-old husband, yesterday morning.

The search resulted in the discovery of a quantity of Ketamine hidden in some bushes at the front of their house.

The two suspects were arrested in connection with the find.

The same party of officers then proceeded to the Curepe district, where they conducted a search of a club, which resulted in quantities of dangerous drugs including ecstasy, ketamine, cocaine and molly, were discovered and seized.

The exercises were spearheaded by ACP Singh, Snr. Supt. Pierre and coordinated by Supt. Gift, ASP Bharath and Insp. Pierre.

In the Southern Division, officers of the Criminal Investigations Department, where on mobile patrol around 9:05 am on Thursday 5th June, 2025, when they stopped a white Nissan B14 motor vehicle in the Ste. Madeleine district.

A search of the vehicle resulted in the discovery of one Glock 17 pistol loaded with a magazine containing nine rounds of ammunition.

The occupants of the vehicle, two men, ages 59 and 29, both of San Fernando, were arrested in connection with the find.
