#### **SIU Strikes Major Blow Against Drug Trafficking, Over TT \$47m in Narcotics Seized in High-Impact Operation**

The Trinidad and Tobago Police Service (TTPS) is applauding the outstanding performance of the Special Investigations Unit (SIU) following a high-impact, intelligence-led operation in the Central Division that resulted in the seizure of over 413 kilograms of Colombian “Creepy” Marijuana, valued at TT \$47,687,266.44.

Between 1:00 p.m. and 4:30 p.m., yesterday, November 26<sup>th</sup>, 2025 officers of the SIU operating under the leadership of Snr. Supt. Edwards, Supt. Etienne, ASP Lynch and ASP Morales, and supported by the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) executed a targeted exercise based on actionable intelligence.

During the operation, a residence in the Central Division was searched under the Emergency Powers Regulation, 2025. Officers uncovered 10 crocus bags and 5 garbage bags containing high-grade cannabis, later weighing 413.68 kg.

The on-site search was expertly supervised by Inspectors Nixon and Ammon.

Two men were taken into custody in connection with the discovery.

Commissioner of Police Allister Guevarro commended the officers sharing that “Today’s operations demonstrated the power of true teamwork across our units. Your skill, discipline, and initiative were evident in every task, and your seamless coordination and resourcefulness enabled the precise and professional execution of complex missions.

This collective effort highlights the value of unity within the service. Your performance exemplifies what dedication and collaboration can achieve, and each of you deserves full commendation.

You have all made me exceptionally proud.”

This significant drug seizure which comes mere hours after a similar operation yesterday with the seizure of \$4.4M in cannabis highlights the exceptional effectiveness, professionalism, and vigilance of the SIU, as they continue to disrupt high-level drug-trafficking operations and safeguard communities across Trinidad and Tobago.
