Firearm, Ammunition, and Narcotics Seized in Northern Division North

A series of coordinated intelligence-led operations conducted across the Northern Division North on Monday 13th October, 2025, resulted in the seizure of a firearm, seven rounds of ammunition, and over three kilograms of marijuana. Two persons were arrested in connection with these exercises.

Between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., officers of the Northern Division Task Force (NDTF) North, acting on intelligence, intercepted a Nissan AD wagon at the East Gates Mall carpark. When the officers searched the vehicle they seized one Taurus pistol and seven rounds of 4.5mm ammunition. Two suspects from Arouca were arrested for Possession of Firearm and Ammunition.

Later that day, between 6:00 p.m. and 9:30 p.m., officers based on information received, went to a residence located at Irvine Road, Petit Bourg, where they seized 2,064 grams of cannabis and a digital scale.

In a separate exercise in the Malabar district, officers found 938 grams of cannabis in a bushy area along One Way Drive, Tumpuna Road.

This exercise was coordinated by ACP Singh, Snr Supt Maynard Wilson, Supt Mc Kenzie, ASP Pitt, ASP Ablacksingh, ASP Jones and Insp Estrada.

Meanwhile, between 10:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. yesterday, officers of the Eastern Division Task Force, Sangre Grande, conducted Operation Steadfast in the Sangre Grande District. The exercise targeted the homes of two persons of interest. During the search of one residence at Gender Road, Fishing Pond, officers discovered and seized a homemade shotgun. Charges are expected to be laid in connection with the find.

Investigations are ongoing.
