Three Held, Firearm and Ammunition Seized and One Stolen Vehicle Recovered in ED and NCD Exercises

Three suspects were arrested and a firearm and quantity of ammunition seized, while a motor vehicle which had been reported stolen, was recovered, during anti-crime exercises, conducted in the Eastern and North Central Divisions.

In the Eastern Division, Task Force officers conducted an intelligence-led exercise between 10 am and 1 pm, on Wednesday 17th September, 2025, in the Valencia district.

During the exercise, the officers proceeded to a quarry along the Eastern Main Road, where they arrested a 24-year-old of Sangre Grande man, who was found to be in possession of a Smith and Wesson revolver and 12 rounds of ammunition.

The operation was coordinated by Snr. Supt. Paponette, ASP (Ag.) Russell, Insp. (Ag.) Ramdeen, Sgt. (Ag.) Hosein and Cpl Singh, all of the Eastern Division.

In the North Central Division, Task Force officers of Areas West and East, with the assistance of officers from the St. Joseph Criminal Investigations Department, conducted an exercise between 2 am and 6 am, in the Curepe district, yesterday.

During the exercise, two male suspects, ages 19 and 18, both of Curepe, were arrested in connection with a report of a break in at Rapsey Street.

Meanwhile, one white Toyota Altis which was stolen during a home invasion incident was recovered in the Valsayn district, by the officers.

The operation was initiated by ACP Singh, Snr. Supt. Gift and coordinated by ASP Bharath, Insp. Pierre, Insp. Peters and Sgt. Pamphille.

Investigations are ongoing into the three above matters.
