Princes Town Woman Granted \$800,000 Bail for Larceny

A 37-year-old Princes Town woman was granted \$800,000 bail with a surety when she appeared virtually yesterday before the Scarborough Magistrates' Court charged with nine counts of larceny.

SAVITRI PERSAD, of Iere Village, Princes Town, is due to reappear in court on December 3rd, 2021.

As part of her bail condition, she was ordered by Magistrate Debby Ann Bassaw to report to the Princes Town Police Station twice per week.

According to police reports, sometime between May 2020 and May 2021, two persons allegedly gave a woman a total of \$203,000, to assist them with an investment with the promise that they would receive a significant return when she received a profit on said investment.

However, both allegedly did not receive any returns on the money they invested.

Police arrested the suspect on November 1st in Tobago after extensive investigations were conducted. She was subsequently charged on November 3rd, 2021 with the offences.

Investigations were conducted by WPC Baynes and PC Moses of the Criminal Investigations Department, Tobago Division.
